POLICIES

The Huntington YMCA Kennedy Center Outdoor Facility provides 80 acres of outdoor recreational activities including an outdoor pool, youth soccer leagues, a fishing lake, a 1 mile walking trail, a high ropes course, and summer sports and day camps.

General Facility Policies and Regulations:

- ❖ Facility is open during the summer months. Please contact the Kennedy Center at 522-0616 or the May Building Member Services at 525-8127 for opening and closing dates.
- ❖ **Pool Times** are as follows:

Mondays	11:00 AM to 8:00 PM
Tuesday thru Saturdays	11:00 AM to 6:00 PM
Sundays	12:00 Noon to 6:00 PM
- ❖ **Pool use is limited to Kennedy Center YMCA members and May Building YMCA members, HHS members may use the pool by paying the guest fee, however, they do not have to be a guest of a May Building or Kennedy Center Member.**
- ❖ The Pool Facility can be rented after operating hours for private use. Contact the Kennedy Center Director or Program Director at 522-0616 for availability and fees or to schedule a private event.
- ❖ Persons are not permitted to use or play on the ropes course equipment without instruction and supervision from the appropriate Huntington YMCA staff person, certified in ropes instruction.
- ❖ The High Ropes Challenge Course provides a team building experience and may be rented by groups or companies. Contact the Kennedy Center Director or Program Director at 522-0616 for availability and fees or to schedule a group challenge.
- ❖ **Only Kennedy Center and May Building Adult Members ages 18 and older are permitted to bring guests.**
- ❖ **Adult members are limited to a maximum of 3 guests per day.**
- ❖ Persons can only be a guest 3 times per month.
- ❖ **Guest Pass Fees:**
 - Guest passes for ages 17 and older are \$5.00 per person.
 - Guest passes for ages 16 and younger are \$1.00 per person.
- ❖ Members 12 years old and younger are not permitted in the facility without an adult member's supervision.

Fishing Lake Policies and Regulations:

- ❖ The fishing lake is stocked by the WV DNR and is open to the public. All persons using this lake must follow current WV DNR fishing regulations as well as the specific regulations posted.
- ❖ Fishing from January 1st to April 30th is limited to youth ages 17 and younger and persons with disabilities. Adults are permitted to fish from May 1st to December 31st.

- ❖ Swimming or boating in the lake is not permitted.
- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
- ❖ Pick up any trash and place in trash cans when finished.

Walking Trail Policies and Regulations:

- ❖ Walking trail is open to the public.
- ❖ Pick up any trash and place in trash cans when finished.
- ❖ Be respectful and considerate of others using the trail.
- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the grounds.

Outdoor Pool Policies and Regulations:

- ❖ Smoking is not permitted on the pool deck.
- ❖ Persons must be 18 years old to smoke. All smoking must be done in the designated areas.
- ❖ Youth over age 9 are not permitted in the mushroom pool.
- ❖ Youth 10 years and older are not permitted in the mushroom pool during the pool breaks.
- ❖ Persons must be 18 years of age or older to lap swim during the pool breaks.
- ❖ Floatation devices are not permitted in the pool.
- ❖ Children are not permitted to use flotation devices unless an adult is in the pool supervising the child.
- ❖ Tennis balls or hard balls are not permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ Food and drink is not permitted beyond the blue lines..
- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the grounds.
- ❖ All coolers and containers may be checked for alcohol or glass containers.
- ❖ Pick up any trash and place in trash cans when finished. Please keep the pool deck clean.
- ❖ Gum is not permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ The diving board is closed during pool breaks.
